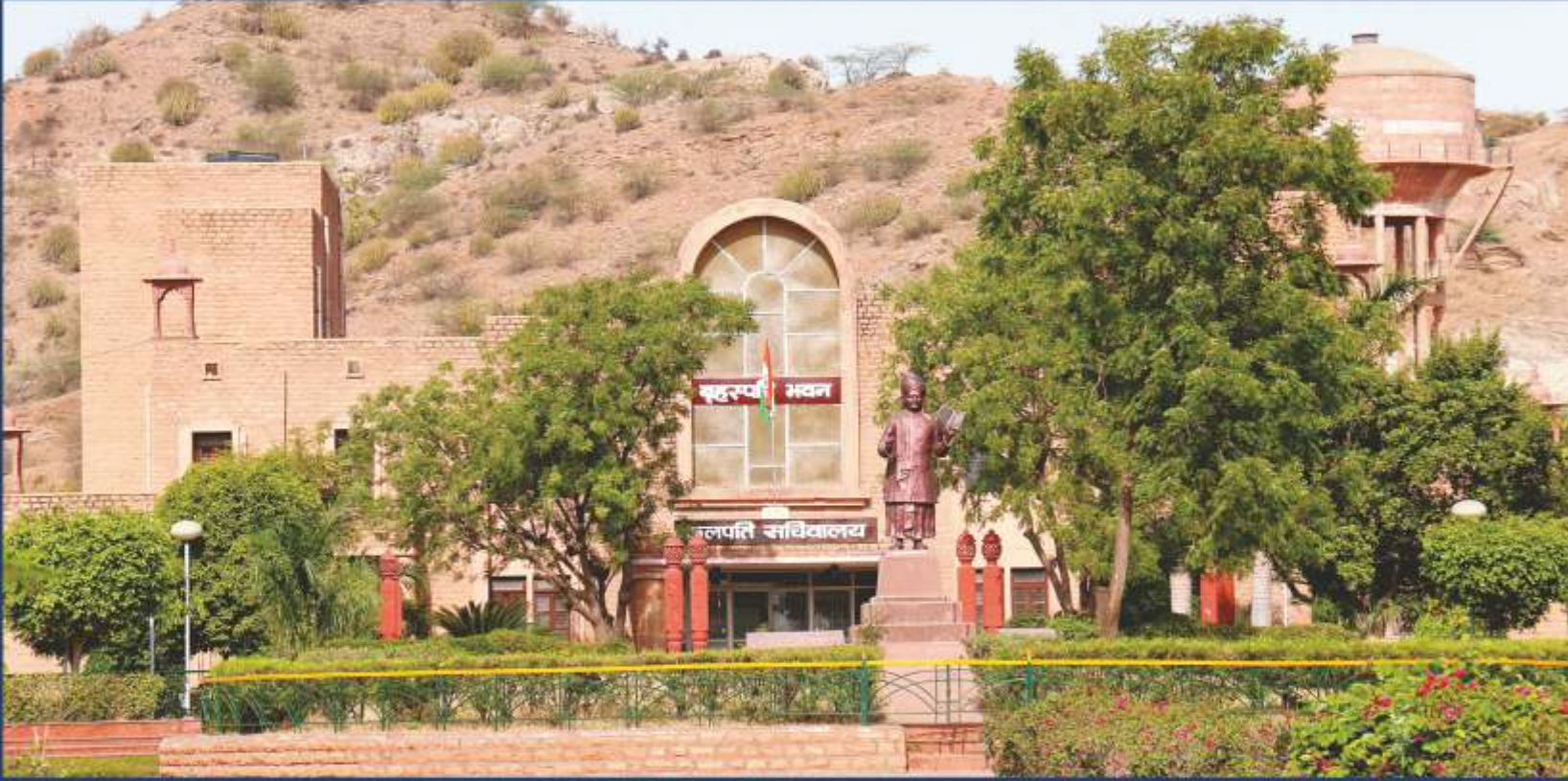

The Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University, Ajmer was established on 1st August, 1987 and successfully completed **36** years. The contribution in the academic field has been remarkable. There has been an astonishing growth in the University infrastructure which includes magnificent buildings, Hi-Tech Science laboratories, a state-of-the-art Computer Centre, a prestigious Library, an Administrative and Examination Block, separate Science, Social Science, Environmental Science, Management Blocks and a highly impressive Vice – Chancellor's secretariat. There are promising job oriented courses and intensive research oriented programmes. There are also Self Financing courses in several teaching Departments. The University was accredited as B++ by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore in 2017. The University Library is unique and the first in the State being fully automated since 2003, having technical and financial support of the UGC's INFLIBNET Centre, Ahmedabad. The Library also has to its credit the excellent functioning of "Shodhganga" wherein all the research work after being checked for plagiarism is regularly uploaded on the University website.

The C-Net Centre, EDU-SAT, Campus wide networking using OFC 6 Core are all a reflection of the emphasis of the University to the fact that gaining knowledge can no longer be restricted to the four walls of any institution. There is always scope to explore research and discover while sailing through the process of gaining education. The Teaching Departments and centres of learning at the University Campus include Botany, Captain Durga Prasad Choudhary Journalism, Commerce, Computer Science, Economics, Education, Environmental Science, Food Science and Nutrition, Hindi, History, Law, Library and Information Science, Management Studies, Mathematics, Microbiology, Political Science, Population Studies, Pure and Applied Chemistry, Remote Sensing and Geo informatics, Vedic Vangamaya, Yogic Science and Human Consciousness and Zoology. There is an Entrepreneurship Centre – CESBM and several Research Centres - Algae Biofuel and Biomolecules Centre, Ambedkar Shodh Peeth, Maharshi Dayanand Shodh Peeth, Samrat Prithviraj Chauhan Shodh Peeth and Sindhu Shodh Peeth. There are **117** Colleges affiliated to this University, which are spread over 4 districts of the State of Rajasthan. The University registered **3,38,000** students for various courses during the **2022-23** session.



AJMER



The city of Ajmer was founded in the 7th Century AD. It has been named after King Ajaypal. Ajmer is a city of rich religious and cultural diversity with a unique blend of Hindu, Muslim, Sikh and Christian culture. It is situated in the picturesque valley of one of the oldest mountain ranges of the world - The Aravalis.

All over the world, the city of Ajmer is known for its Dargah, a shrine of the Sufi Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti and Pushkar, a holy pilgrimage lake; supposed to have appeared miraculously, when a lotus flower fell from the hands of Lord Brahma and dropped at this place. The Brahma temple (the only temple of Brahma in the world) is situated at Pushkar.

The rich architectural heritage of Ajmer includes Soni Ji Ki Nasiyan (Jain temple), Adhai-Din-Ka Jhopara, Taragarh Fort, Baradari at Anasagar, Prithviraj Smarak, Nareli, Sai Baba Ka Mandir and Bhakti Dham (Charan Shodh Sansthan).

The city had been a workplace of the great social reformer of the 19th Century, Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati. The name of the University as Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University was given after this apostle of Vedic and Aryan ethos. In addition, Ajmer is an epicenter of educational institutions and is renowned for handicraft work, paintings and as a marble hub at Kishangarh Town which has the biggest marble mandi in Asia.

The Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University is situated in the lap of the Central Aravalli hill ranges, the Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University presents a panoramic view of a mix of beautiful landscape and architecture. ELIGIBILITY

Ph.D.

A candidate for admission to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) must have obtained the Master's degree with at least 55 percent marks at the postgraduate examination of the University or an equivalent examination recognized by the University in the subject or any allied subject in which he/she wishes to pursue research. If the candidate secures less than 55 percent marks at the postgraduate examination but has secured second division at postgraduate as well as degree level, he/she will be eligible for admission to Ph. D. Programme.

The candidate seeking admission in Ph.D Programme are advised to go through the ordinance no. 124 relating to the degree of Ph.D. A Separate Advertisement (Admission Notice) will appear in the state level newspapers for Research Entrance Test (RET) only on the availability of seats and admission to the Ph.D. programme in various subjects offered by the University.

SCIENCE

• M.Sc. Botany (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

M.Sc. Botany is the program of learning in semester system. Department of Botany established in the year 1990 and engaged continuously not only in nurturing the budding botanist but also creating the knowledge in subject domain. Department has well equipped state of art laboratories to provide hand on practical training in the subject.

M. Sc. Botany program is in high demand in academia, agriculture and industry as well. Department provides specialization in Plant Pathology, Plant Physiology and Plant Ecology.

Eligibility: 50% marks in aggregate in B.Sc. with Botany or B.Sc. Hons. (Botany).

M.Sc. Environmental Science (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

M. Sc. Environmental Science is a program of learning under modular Choice Based Credit System that allows a student exit points after the successful completion of each semester. If the student is successful till the exit point s/he desires to leave at, s/he will be awarded PG Certificate/Diploma /Advanced Diploma/Degree. Such student may return back within two years of exit to seek lateral entry and complete the program. The minimum requirements for such provisions are as below:

- Semester 1 (6 months, 22 credits) for PG Certificate in Environmental Science.
- Semesters 2 (1 year, 44 credits) for PG Diploma in Environmental Science
- Semesters 3 (1.5 years, 66 credits) for Advanced PG Diploma in Environmental Science
- Semesters 4 (2 years, 88 credits) for M.Sc. Environmental Science

विज्ञान

एम.एससी. वनस्पति विज्ञान (सेमस्टर परीक्षा योजना) (20 सीट)

वनस्पति विज्ञान में निष्णात कार्यक्रम समसत्र परीक्षा योजना में अध्ययन हेतु उपलब्ध है। वनस्पति शास्त्र विभाग 1990 में स्थापित हुआ तथा स्थापना से ही अनवरत रूप से न केवल नवांकुरित वनस्पतिज्ञों को पोषित कर रहा है बल्कि विषय के दर्शन में सतत रूप से ज्ञान का सृजन एवं विस्तार कर रहा है। विभाग की सुसज्जित प्रयोगशालायें विषय के प्रायोगिक एवं व्यक्तिगत प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करने हेतु समुचित सुविधा प्रदान करती हैं।

वनस्पति शास्त्र में निष्णात उपाधि धारकों की अकादमिक, कृषि एवं औद्योगिक क्षेत्र में भारी मांग रहती है। विभाग में पादप रोग विज्ञान, पादप कार्बोन्स एवं पादप पारिस्थितिकी में विशेषज्ञता हेतु विकल्प उपलब्ध है।

प्रवेश हेतु योग्यता : स्नातक में न्यूनतम 50% समग्र प्राप्तांक (मुख्य विषय के रूप में वनस्पति विज्ञान विषय के साथ) अथवा स्नातक ऑनर्स (वनस्पति विज्ञान)

एम.एससी. पर्यावरण विज्ञान (सेमस्टर स्कीम) (20 सीट)

एम.एससी. पर्यावरण विज्ञान विकल्प आधारित क्रेडिट सिस्टम प्रोग्राम है जिसमें विद्यार्थियों को प्रत्येक सेमस्टर में सफल होने के लिए न्यूनतम निर्धारित क्रेडिट पूरा करना आवश्यक है। यदि विद्यार्थी एक्जिट पॉइन्ट तक सफल होता है/इच्छानुसार कोर्स छोड़ना चाहता है। उसे स्नातकोत्तर प्रमाण पत्र/डिप्लोमा/एडवांस्ड डिप्लोमा/डिग्री दी जाएगी। इस प्रकार के विद्यार्थी कोर्स छोड़ने से दो वर्ष की अवधि तक पार्श्व प्रविष्टि लेकर प्रोग्राम पूर्ण कर सकते हैं। इस प्रकार के प्रावधानों के लिए न्यूनतम आवश्यकताएं इस प्रकार हैं-

- सेमस्टर 1 (6 माह, 22 श्रेयांक) पी.जी. प्रमाण पत्र पर्यावरण विज्ञान में
- सेमस्टर 2 (1 वर्ष, 44 श्रेयांक) पी.जी. डिप्लोमा पर्यावरण विज्ञान
- सेमस्टर 3 (1.5 वर्ष, 66 श्रेयांक) एडवांस्ड पी.जी. डिप्लोमा पर्यावरण विज्ञान एवं
- सेमस्टर 4 (2 वर्ष, 88 श्रेयांक) एम.एससी. पर्यावरण विज्ञान

Eligibility: 50% marks in aggregate in B.Sc. With Medical or Non Medical group, Engineering or Bachelor's degree in Environmental Science/Geology/Earth Science/Microbiology/ Biotechnology/Biochemistry/ Agriculture/ Horticulture/ Forestry/Wildlife/Life Science

The Department established in 1993 offers M.Sc. Environmental Science course with specialization in Environmental Impact Assessment and Disaster Management, which makes it unique in the country. The course curriculum is extensive and extremely relevant to the present day context. Hands-on-training is provided in laboratory exercises to promote the learning of appropriate environmental technologies. The students are sensitized for the preservation and management of Earth and its resources in a sustainable manner.

M.Sc. Foods and Nutrition (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

The Department was established in the year 1994. The Post Graduate programme is of four Semesters. The Department has adequate infrastructure and laboratory facilities. The M.Sc. Programme includes various subjects like Nutritional Biochemistry, Therapeutic Nutrition, Food Science, Food Analysis, Food Microbiology, Public Nutrition, Human Nutrition etc. As part of the M.Sc. Programme the students undergo Internship in reputed Hospitals of the country. The students find placements as Dieticians, Health Counsellors in Food Industries, NGO's and on teaching positions in Colleges and Universities.

Eligibility: 50% marks at degree level in B.Sc. Home Science (Pass Course/Honours) / B.Sc. Foods and Nutrition / B.Sc. Food Science / B.Sc. in Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics / B.Sc. Biotechnology / PG Diploma in Nutrition and Dietetics.

M.Sc. Applied Chemistry (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

Eligibility: 50% marks in aggregate in B. Sc. with Chemistry as one of the optional subjects or in B. Sc. Honours (Chemistry)

M.Sc. Chemistry (SFS) (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

Eligibility: 50% marks in aggregate in B.Sc. with Chemistry as one of the optional subjects or in B.Sc. Hons. (Chemistry)

The department established in April 1994 with the founder member as present Head of Department has the recognition of having several alumni of the two post graduate courses working in good positions in industries, railways, government offices, government colleges of Rajasthan and other academic institutions of repute, engineering colleges of Rajasthan, forensic laboratories and many others. The department has extensively published at both national and international level.

योग्यता/पात्रता: कुल 50% अंक बी.एस.सी. मेडीकल और नॉन मेडीकल ग्रुप, अभियांत्रिकी या स्नातक डिग्री पर्यावरण विज्ञान/ जियोलॉजी/ अर्थसाइंस/ माइक्रोबायोलॉजी/ बायोटेक्नोलॉजी/ बायोकेमिस्ट्री/ एग्रीकल्चर/ हार्टीकल्चर/ फॉरेस्ट्री/ वाइल्डलाइफ/लाईफ साइंस विभाग 1993 में स्थापित हुआ जो पर्यावरण विज्ञान में एम.एस.सी. के साथ पर्यावरण प्रभाव आंकलन व आपदा प्रबंधन में विशेषज्ञता करवाता है जो कि देश में इसे अद्वितीय बनाता है। विभाग पाठ्यक्रम विस्तृत व वर्तमान समय के अनुसार अत्यंत प्रासंगिक है। प्रयोगशाला अभ्यास में व्यक्तिगत प्रशिक्षण सटीक पर्यावरणीय तकनीक को सही दिशा में बढ़ावा देता है। विद्यार्थियों को पृथ्वी और उसके प्राकृतिक संसाधनों के स्थाई तरीके से संरक्षण व प्रबंधन के प्रति अत्यधिक संवेदनशील बनाया जाता है।

स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम खाद्य एवं पोषण (सेमेस्टर स्कीम) (20 सीट)

इस विभाग की स्थापना वर्ष 1994 में हुई थी। इस स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम में चार सेमेस्टर हैं। विभाग में पर्याप्त आधारभूत सुविधाएं एवं प्रयोगशालाएं हैं। स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम में विभिन्न विषय सम्मिलित हैं जैसे न्यूट्रीशनल बायोकेमेस्ट्री, थेराप्यूटिक न्यूट्रीशन, फूड साइन्स, फूड एनेलिसिस, फूड माइक्रोबायोलॉजी, पब्लिक न्यूट्रीशन, ह्यूमन न्यूट्रीशन इत्यादि। स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम के तहत विद्यार्थी देश के प्रतिष्ठित अस्पतालों में प्रशिक्षण (इन्टर्नशिप) लेते हैं। विद्यार्थियों को रोजगार के रूप में आहारविद्, स्वास्थ्य परामर्शदाता खाद्य उद्योगों में, गैर सरकारी संस्थाओं में एवं महाविद्यालयों तथा विश्वविद्यालयों में शिक्षक के पद पर कार्य करने के अवसर मिलते हैं।

योग्यता : बी.एस.सी. गृह विज्ञान (पास कोर्स/ऑनर्स)/बी.एस.सी. खाद्य एवं पोषण/ बी.एस.सी. खाद्य विज्ञान / बी.एस.सी. क्लिनिकल न्यूट्रीशन एवं डायटेटिक्स /बी.एस.सी. जैव तकनीकी /पी.जी. डिप्लोमा इन न्यूट्रीशन एवं डायटेटिक्स- 50 प्रतिशत अंकों के साथ।

एम.एस.सी. एवं अनुप्रयुक्त रसायन (सेमेस्टर स्कीम) (20 सीट)

योग्यता: बी. एस.सी. (रसायन विज्ञान वैकल्पिक विषयों में से एक) या बी. एस.सी. ऑनर्स (रसायन विज्ञान) में समग्र 50% अंक।

योग्यता: बी. एस.सी. (जिसमें रसायन विज्ञान वैकल्पिक विषयों में से एक) या बी. एस.सी. ऑनर्स (रसायन विज्ञान) में समग्र 50% अंक।

अप्रैल 1994 में स्थापित विभाग जिसके संस्थापक सदस्य विभाग के वर्तमान में विभागाध्यक्ष हैं के दोनों स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रमों ने अनेक पूर्व छात्र विभिन्न उद्योगों, रेलवे, सरकारी कार्यालयों, राजस्थान के सरकारी कॉलेजों और ख्याति प्राप्त अन्य शैक्षणिक संस्थानों, राजस्थान के इंजीनियरिंग कॉलेज, फॉरेंसिक प्रयोगशालाओं एवं कई अन्य संस्थानों में अच्छे पदों पर कार्य कर रहे हैं। विभाग ने बड़े पैमाने पर राष्ट्रीय और अंतर्राष्ट्रीय दोनों स्तरों पर प्रकाशन किया है।

M.Sc. Microbiology (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

M.Sc. (Microbiology) is a program of learning based on the standards decided by the New National Education Policy under Choice Based Credit System. It comprises of 19 different skill honing courses.

Eligibility: B.Sc./ B.Sc. Hons./ B.Sc. B.Ed. in any discipline of Biology/B.Sc. (Ag)/Graduate degree in medical or paramedical sciences/Graduate degree in Liberal Arts with any discipline of biology/B. Tech. (Biotechnology/Biochemical Engineering/ Agricultural Engineering) with minimum 50% marks.

M.Sc. Biotechnology (SFS) (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

M.Sc. (Biotechnology) is a program of learning based on the standards decided by the New National Education Policy under Choice Based Credit System. It comprises of 14 different skill honing courses.

Eligibility: B.Sc./ B.Sc. Hons./ B.Sc. B.Ed. in any discipline of Biology/B.Sc. (Ag)/Graduate degree in medical or paramedical sciences/Graduate degree in Liberal Arts with any discipline of biology/B. Tech. (Biotechnology/Biochemical Engineering/ Agricultural Engineering) with minimum 50% marks.

Department: The University started the first ever M.Sc. Microbiology program of Rajasthan in 1993. The department started M.Sc. Biotechnology from the year 2020. With a motto "Unveil the hidden strength", the faculty tries unveiling the hidden strength of the students and that of the invisible friends. The department gained its unique identity by establishing two research centers recognized by the Department of Biotechnology and the Ministry of Environment and Forests of Government of India, respectively. Its research focus on desert microorganisms earned inclusion in Earth Microbiome Project and subsequent authorship contribution for an article on microbial diversity in the world's most prestigious scientific journal "Nature". The faculty has US patent on mist-based algae production system. It developed cyanobacterial and Moringa biopolymer based moist wound dressings and presented a detailed protocol on evaluation of such materials for wound care. It also developed a novel interactive biosorption technique to remove anions from water.

M.Sc. Remote Sensing & Geo-informatics (Semester Scheme) • [20 Seats]

Eligibility : Bachelor of Natural, Physical & Earth Sciences/ Geography, Engineering or Master's Degree in Natural, Physical and Earth Science including geography with 55% marks at graduate/ Post graduate level. Candidates should have stereoscopic normal vision.

The Department is unique being the only one of its kind among all universities of the state offering M.Sc. program in this subject. The students are getting placement as Scientist in ISRO and DRDO, State centre of Remote Sensing, Multinational Companies like ROLTA, RMSI, TCI etc. and in foreign countries like Canada, UAE, Belgium, Brazil and USA (NASA). The Department is having many projects sanctioned by University Grants Commission, New Delhi, ISRO and Ministry of Environment and Forests, New Delhi.

एम. एस.सी. सूक्ष्मजीव विज्ञान (सेमेस्टर स्कीम) (20 सीट)

विज्ञान निष्णात (जैवतकनीकी) (स्वतंत्र प्रणाली) (समसत्र प्रणाली) (20 सीट)

विज्ञान निष्णात (जैवतकनीकी), नई राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति के मानकों के आधार पर संरचित चयन एवं श्रेयांक आधारित शैक्षणिक कार्यक्रम है। इस उपाधि कार्यक्रम में कौशल विकास हेतु 14 पाठ्यक्रम शामिल हैं।

योग्यता: न्यूनतम 50% अंकों के साथ जीवविज्ञान के किसी भी विषय/कृषि अथवा आयुर्विज्ञान/पराआयुर्विज्ञान में स्नातक/ विज्ञान व शिक्षा स्नातक/ स्नातक ऑनर्स अथवा जैवप्रौद्योगिकी/जैवरासायनिक अभियांत्रिकी/ कृषि में अभियांत्रिकी स्नातक की उपाधि।

विभाग: राजस्थान का सर्वप्रथम विज्ञान निष्णात (सूक्ष्मजीवविज्ञान) शैक्षणिक कार्यक्रम महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती विश्वविद्यालय अजमेर में वर्ष 1993 में आरंभ हुआ। विभाग में विज्ञान निष्णात (जैवतकनीकी) शैक्षणिक कार्यक्रम वर्ष 2020 से आरंभ किया गया है। सूक्ष्मजीवविज्ञान विभाग का ध्येय वाक्य है: "अदृश्य शक्ति का अनावरण"। विभाग अपने छात्रों का परिचय, उनकी और अदृश्य जीवों की छिपी हुई शक्तियों से कराने की कोशिश करता है। विभाग भारत सरकार के जैवतकनीकी विभाग और पर्यावरण एवं वन मंत्रालय द्वारा स्वीकृत दो शोध केन्द्रों से अपनी पहचान बना चुका है। विभाग का शोध मरुस्थलीय सूक्ष्मजीवों पर केन्द्रित है। संकाय सदस्य भू-सूक्ष्मजीव क्षेत्र परियोजना का हिस्सा हैं और इस नाते विज्ञान की सर्वाधिक मान्यता प्राप्त शोधपत्रिका नेचर में सूक्ष्मजीव वैविध्य पर छप्पे शोधपत्र के लेखकों में शामिल हैं। संकाय को नीहार द्वारा शैवाल उत्पादन प्रक्रिया पर अमेरिकन पेटेंट हासिल है। घावों के शीघ्र उपचार हेतु नील हरित शैवाल और सहजने के जैव बहुलकों से नम अर्धठोस पड्डियाँ संकाय ने विकसित की हैं साथ ही ऐसी सामग्री के मूल्यांकन हेतु वृहद विस्तृत प्रयोग पद्धतियाँ चिन्हित की हैं। संकाय ने जल से ऋणायनों को अलग करने के लिए एक नवीन अंतरक्रियात्मक जैव शोषण पद्धति भी विकसित की है।

एम.एस.सी. सुदूर संवेदन एवं भू-सूचना (छमाही योजना) (स्थान : 20)

योग्यता : प्राकृतिक, भौतिक, पृथ्वी विज्ञान, भूगोल, यन्त्र शास्त्र में स्नातक या प्राकृतिक, भौतिकी, पृथ्वी विज्ञान और भूगोल में स्नातक व स्नातकोत्तर में 55 प्रतिशत अंकों के साथ उत्तीर्ण विद्यार्थियों को स्टीरियोस्कोपिक सामान्य दृष्टि होनी चाहिए।

यह विभाग राज्य के सभी विश्वविद्यालयों के बीच अपनी तरह का एकमात्र संस्थान है जिसमें सुदूर संवेदन विषय में स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम चलता है। इस विषय में स्नातकोत्तर उपरान्त छात्रों का भारतीय अंतरिक्ष अनुसंधान संगठन (इसरो), रक्षा अनुसंधान एवं विकास संगठन (डी.आर.डी.ओ), राज्य स्तर के सुदूर संवेदी सरकारी विभागों, बहुराष्ट्रीय संगठन जैसे रोल्टा, आर.एम.एस.आई., टी.सी.एल आदि विदेशी देशी जैसे कनाडा, संयुक्त अरब अमीरात (यू.ए.ई), बेल्जियम, ब्राजील, अमेरिका (नासा) में रोजगार के सुनहरे अवसर मिल रहे हैं। यह विभाग विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग, नई दिल्ली, भारतीय अंतरिक्ष अनुसंधान संगठन (इसरो) और पर्यावरण एवं वन मंत्रालय, नई दिल्ली द्वारा स्वीकृत कई परियोजनाओं को मंजूरी दे रहा है।

M.Sc./M.A. Geography (Semester Scheme) • [20 Seats]

Eligibility

1. Graduate from any Board/University of Rajasthan having at least 55% marks.
2. Graduates outside Rajasthan must have at least 60% marks.
3. Rest of the rules are as per Admission Policy 2021 issued by Commissionerate, College Education Rajasthan (Pg. No. 9-11)

Geography is a broad based subject which provides lots of opportunities for future progression. Geography is an obvious choice for careers in sustainability and green issues, urban regeneration, energy supply, retail location, managing the effects of hazards and climate change. For careers in the world of business, an understanding of global economics forms an important part of geography. Other burning issues like human rights, international relations or welfare, development, Migration and Pandemics.

M.Sc. Mathematics (SFS) (Semester Scheme) • [40 Seats]

Eligibility: 50% marks in aggregate in B.Sc. with Mathematics as optional subjects or B.Sc. (Hons.) Mathematics.

M.Sc. Mathematics is a 2-year post graduation course that consists of 4 semesters. This is a program of learning under choice based credit systems. This course deals with the detailed study of mathematics and giving students an upper hand in advanced mathematics knowledge and mathematical research. MSc Mathematics emphasizes the importance and uses of mathematics in different fields. The subjects provide the students with the necessary mathematical knowledge and ways to use mathematics at different stages of life or at work and the importance of advance mathematics in the present technological world. Mathematics can be applied in various fields such as data analytics, lecturing, engineering, etc

M.Sc. Zoology (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats] + [20 Seats SFS]

The Department offers master level program with advanced papers like molecular biology, techniques etc. Emphasis is given on CSIR-NET syllabus during M.Sc. level study, also focused on study of animal behavior and biodiversity in nature. Department is equipped with modern facilities for microphotography, DNA sequencing, ultra sensitive biochemistry, sound spectrum analysis, digital alternatives of animal anatomy and physiology, teaching with smart class board.

Eligibility : 50% marks in aggregate in B.Sc. with Chemistry and Zoology as optional subjects or B.Sc. (Hons.) Zoology.

एम.एससी. गणित (स्ववित्त पोषित) (छमाही योजना) (स्थान : 40)

योग्यता : बी.एस.सी में कुल 50% अंक गणित के साथ वैकल्पिक विषय या बीएससी (ऑनर्स) गणित के रूप में ।

एमएससी गणित 2 साल का पोस्ट ग्रेजुएशन कोर्स है जिसमें 4 सेमेस्टर होते हैं। यह पसंद आधारित क्रेडिट सिस्टम के तहत सीखने का एक कार्यक्रम है। यह पाठ्यक्रम गणित के विस्तृत अध्ययन और छात्रों को उन्नत गणित ज्ञान और गणितीय अनुसंधान में एक ऊपरी हाथ देने से संबंधित है। एम.एससी गणित विभिन्न क्षेत्रों में गणित के महत्व और उपयोग पर जोर देता है। विषय छात्रों को आवश्यक गणितीय ज्ञान और जीवन के विभिन्न चरणों में या काम पर और वर्तमान तकनीकी दुनिया में अग्रिम गणित के महत्व पर गणित का उपयोग करने के तरीके प्रदान करते हैं। गणित को विभिन्न क्षेत्रों जैसे डेटा एनालिटिक्स, व्याख्यान, इंजीनियरिंग, आदि में लागू किया जा सकता है।

स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम प्राणीशास्त्र विज्ञान (सेमेस्टर प्रणाली) (20 सीट)

विभाग में आणविक जीव विज्ञान आदि विषयों के साथ स्नातकोत्तर (प्राणीविज्ञान) पाठ्यक्रम प्रदान करता है। स्नातकोत्तर (प्राणीविज्ञान) पाठ्यक्रम के दौरान CSIR-NET पाठ्यक्रम पर विशेष जोर दिया जाता है। पाठ्यक्रम में सजीव जन्तु व्यवहार और जैव विविधता अध्ययन पर भी ध्यान केंद्रित किया गया है। विभाग माइक्रोफोटोग्राफी, डीएनए अनुक्रमण, अति संवेदनशील जैव रसायन, ध्वनि स्पेक्ट्रम विश्लेषण, जन्तु शरीर रचना विज्ञान और शरीर विज्ञान के डिजिटल विकल्पों के लिए आधुनिक सुविधाओं से परिपूर्ण है। शिक्षण स्मार्ट क्लास बोर्ड द्वारा कराया जाता है।

योग्यता: बी.एस.सी. में औसत 50 प्रतिशत प्राप्तांक के साथ रसायन विज्ञान एवं प्राणीशास्त्र विषय अथवा प्राणीशास्त्र ऑनर्स होना अनिवार्य है।

COMPUTER SCIENCE

The Department of Computer Science was established in the year 1994 with a vision to impart quality post graduate education and to carry out leading-edge research in the disciplines of Computer Science and Information Technology.

The Department currently takes care of three academic programs leading to the award of M. Tech Computer Science, MCA (2 years), BCA (Hons.) and PGDCA. The Department is also engaged in research work in Spatial Database Management Systems, Biometrics & Ad-hoc Networking.

The Department has well equipped laboratories with state-of-the-art computing facilities to support the research and teaching activities for open source, Object Oriented DBMS, Grid computing, BIGDATA, Machine Learning, Medical Image Processing and GIS.

Eligibility: M. Sc. (CS) / M. Sc. (IT), M. Sc. (Physics, M. Sc. (Math), MCA and B.E. /B. Tech. with minimum 50%

MCA (Regular) 2 Years (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

Eligibility: BCA / BSC (CS) / BSC (IT) / Vocational / BSC (Maths / Bio) / (B.A. or B.Com with Math as one of the subjects in graduation) with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

• M. A. Economics (Annual Scheme) [20 Seats]

Eligibility: 48% marks in aggregate at graduate level.

• M. B. A. (Business Economics) (Semester Scheme) [20 Seats]

Eligibility : Bachelor's Degree of Hons./ Pass in Economics/ Commerce with 48% marks or Bachelor's/ Master's degree in any discipline with 50% marks in aggregate.

The Department came into existence in early 1990's and has played a pivotal role in contributing to the growth of the academic environment in the university. The two courses being run by the department prove to be highly popular and the resultant placement of the passing out students has been most gratifying.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Admission to various programmes of study in the University is regulated by admission policy and procedure approved by the Academic Council of the University from time to time.

ADMISSION NOTICE

1. Only online applications will be accepted.
2. One may apply for any number of courses by repeating the process of online admission for each program of learning.
3. Submit online fee of Rs. 300/- per course/program of learning.
4. Filling of the application form would require following documents that one may keep handy as scanned copies. (The size of single scan file to be uploaded is limited to 300kb):
 - a. Recent passport size photograph
 - b. Any identity card recognized for the government offices viz. Aadhar Card, Voter card, Driving License etc.
 - c. Marksheets of each year of the qualifying examination
 - d. All required certificates as proof to claim reservations, if any.
 - e. All required certificates as proof to claim bonus marks, if any.
 - f. It is mandatory for every applicant to attach copy of marksheet of I Year, II Year, III + IV year (if applicable) for Calculation of merit for admission to M.Sc. (Applied Chemistry, Chemistry, Botany & Zoology).



ADMISSION COMMITTEE

Head/ In Charge of each department/Director of a Centre shall constitute a Departmental Admission Committee (DAC) to finalize the admissions as per the rules of the University. The Committee will have Head/In Charge of the Department/ Director of the Centre as the Convener of the Admission Committee along with minimum of one faculty member nominated by the Head/In Charge/ Director as Member and the Office clerk as the Member Secretary. The member secretary will maintain the records and assist in the procedures.

ADMISSION BOARD/GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

Admission Board may be referred to by an Admission Committee for the matters related to admission rules/interpretation of rules. It would also act as Grievance Redressal Committee. The Board for the session **2023-24** will consist of the following.

PROCEDURE

GENERAL RULES

1. Admission to various post graduate courses shall be offered to those graduates who have passed with the 10+2+3 examination scheme.
2. Students shall not be eligible for admission to a course unless they have passed the qualifying examination or any other examination recognized for the purpose and possess such other qualification (if any) as may be prescribed by the Ordinances.
3. A course in the department shall not be started in an academic session if the number of eligible candidates is less than 10 in the Post Graduate/ Diploma Courses. In case of M.Phil the minimum number of eligible candidates is 10 in M.Phil (SFS) and 05 in M.Phil (Regular). In case the course is not started by the department due to unavailability of minimum number of students for admission the fee deposited by the students shall be refunded.
4. All admissions will be provisional till the applicant completes all the formalities required.
5. Candidates called for admission shall be required to appear at their own expenses before the admission committee of the Department concerned on the dates notified by the University/ Head of the Department for verification of documents.
6. At the time of admission, the applicant must furnish original copies of all documents for verification along with Transfer Certificate or Migration Certificate as the case may be, from the Institution last attended by him/her. However the admission of the Candidate will be considered provisional till all the original documents required for admission are submitted within the stipulated time/date notified by the Head of the Department.
7. The applicant shall give an undertaking that if any of the certificates submitted by him/her is found incorrect, his/her admission shall be cancelled.
8. Admission of Candidates with a Supplementary : An applicant who is declared eligible to appear at the supplementary examination may be provisionally admitted, at his/her own risk, to the next higher class in the beginning of the session by the last day fixed for admission subject to the conditions mentioned in the clause given below. He/she will be assumed to have secured minimum pass marks in the subject of supplementary examination for the purpose of preparation of merit list for admission.
9. A candidate who fails or absents himself at the supplementary examination shall have no right to continue in the next higher class and his/her provisional admission to the next higher class shall stand cancelled automatically. In such cases the Fee shall not be refunded.
10. Admission of in-service candidates: In-service candidates may be allowed admission to the various courses on the production of "No Objection-Cum-Character Certificate" from their employers, without which their applications will not be considered. This Certificate must be produced within the stipulated time period recommended by the concerned Admission Committee of the Department failing which the candidate will be denied admission.
11. 75% attendance is compulsory in all courses as per Supreme Court directions and Board of Management (BOM) Resolution.
12. **The prevalent Admission Policy of the Government of Rajasthan will be adhered to.**

CLARIFICATIONS

1. Acceptance of application form does not guarantee admission. Admissions will be made on the basis of merit subject to the availability of the number of seats for each course and subject to fulfillment of the conditions laid down by the University for the purpose from time to time.
2. A candidate should submit a separate application form for each subject / course. If a candidate is not admitted in a course applied for his application would not be transferred in any other department even if a vacancy exists in that department. A candidate is required to apply separately for each course in time in the prescribed application form.
3. The student who has secured higher percentage of marks without the addition of concessional marks shall rank higher in order of merit than the one who has secured the same percentage of marks with the addition of the concessional marks allowed to him under the rules.
4. Number of students will be restricted to the sanctioned strength prescribed for each course in the university teaching departments. Any change in the number of the seats recommended by the Head of the Department shall be enforced only by the permission of the Vice Chancellor.
5. In the case of one who is a regular student or an ex-student of the department in the previous session and who is otherwise eligible, a bare pass in the last examination is enough for admission to the next higher class provided his/her conduct and character has been satisfactory.
6. A student shall not be admitted as a regular student after graduation for more than three degrees/ diploma/ certificate courses of six years as a regular student.
7. A Candidate can opt for admission into Certificate/ Diploma/ Advance Diploma Courses simultaneously along with the Graduation/ Post-Graduation Courses.
8. All the relevant ordinances at the University shall be applicable in the admission procedure.

As per Rajasthan Government Admission Policy FOR PG

- 3.1.4 Failed student will not be admitted again as a regular student in the same course, but he/she can be given admission in any other postgraduate course on the basis of marks secured in the graduate examination.
- 3.1.5 No candidate will be given more than two chances for admission as a Regular Candidate in the first year of any post graduate/course (two post graduation courses or one undergraduate course and graduation/post graduation in Law or one post graduation course and post graduate Diploma).
- 3.1.7 In case of admission of qualified student to the next year after gap year(s), the terms and conditions mentioned in rule 2.3 will be applicable as usual.

For admission to the 1st Year of any PG Programme there will be no restriction regarding the gap years.

FOR UG

Admission after gap year(s):

- 2.3.1 After having passed in a qualifying examination if a candidate does not seek admission in the next year for a period of more than two academic sessions then he/she will not be allowed further admission in the course.
- 2.3.1 The above mentioned rules regarding interval will not apply to female candidates, deaf, dumb and blind candidate.

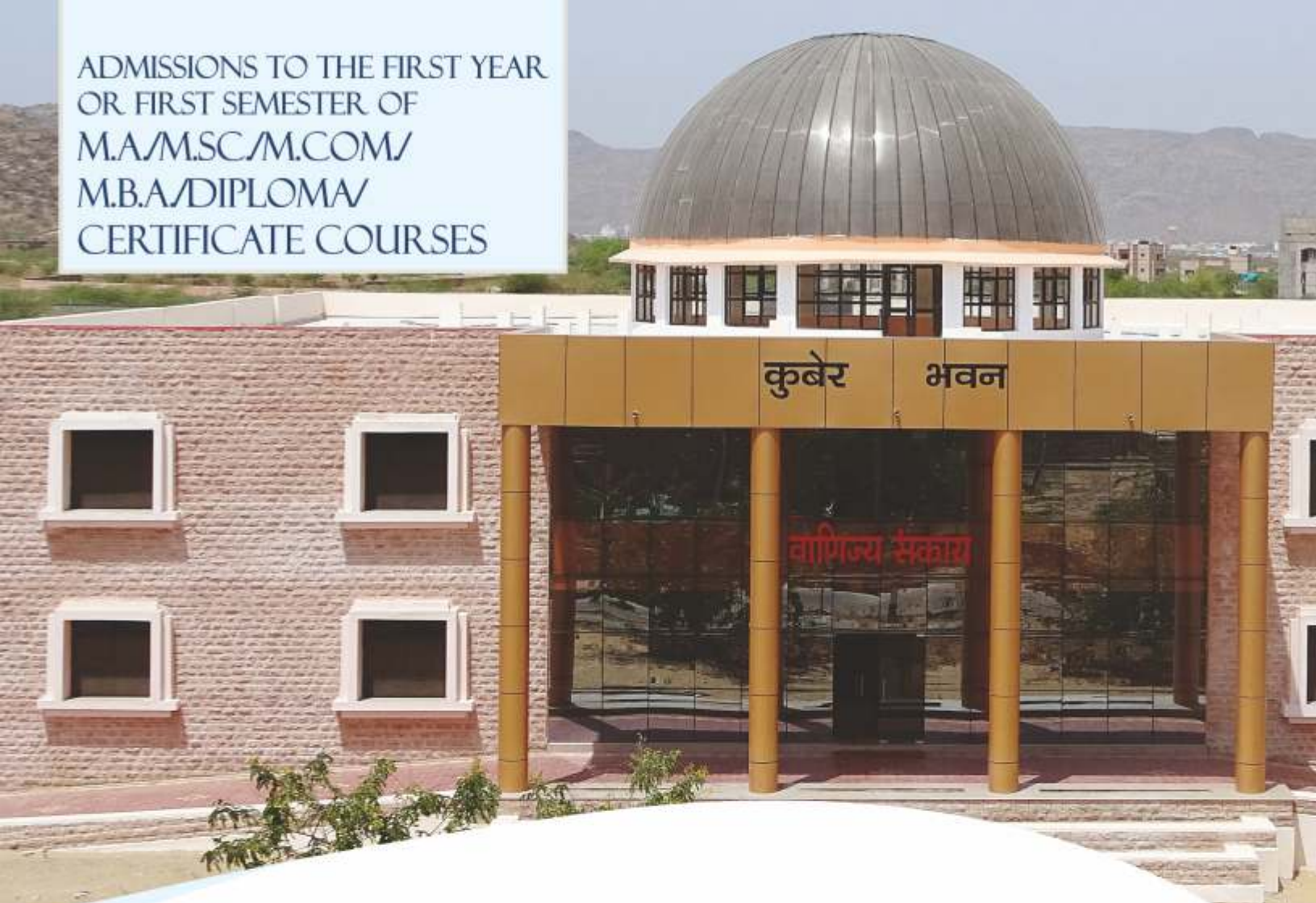

ADMISSIONS TO THE FIRST YEAR

CERTIFICATE COURSES



1. The merit of a candidate for admission in M.Sc./ M.Com. course shall be calculated by adding the marks obtained by him/her at the qualifying examination (Bachelor's degree) to the marks obtained by him/her during the three/four years examination in the subject concerned in which he/she seeks admission to his/her Post Graduation course in case when candidate has studied the concerned subject at the graduation level. This grand total will be converted into percentage taking into account the grand total of the maximum marks of the qualifying examination and the maximum marks of the three/four years of examinations in the subject concerned. In a case when candidate has not studied the concerned subject at graduate level in which candidate seeks admission to his/her post graduation course then the percentage of total aggregate marks obtained by the candidate at the qualifying examination shall be used for making the merit list. The merit of the candidates seeking admission in the undergraduate courses will be determined on the basis of marks obtained at the qualifying examination.
2. The merit list of subject and non-subject candidates for admission to a Post Graduate course in the faculties of Social Sciences shall be prepared separately on the basis of aggregate marks at the degree level. Not more than 20 percent of the total seats shall be filled in from the non subject candidates. However, left over subject seats if any, could be filled in by the non-subject candidates.
3. The procedure of admission in MBA will be governed by the guidelines of the government of Rajasthan.
4. For Diploma/Certificate courses the preparation of merit list will be done as per the norms of the concerned Department as approved by the University
5. If the candidate has grades mentioned in the mark-sheet of any university/institution, the conversion to marks will be done as per the information provided in the mark-sheet or by the university/institution concerned.



6. Whenever two or more candidates obtain equal percentage of marks in merit, the percentage of marks obtained at graduate level by such candidates shall be taken into account for deciding the merit. If candidates are still having the same percentage of marks then the Senior Secondary marks shall be taken into account and if candidates are still having the same percentage of marks then the marks obtained in the Secondary examination will be taken into account to decide the merit.
7. The merit list shall take into account the concessions or relaxations if any, as applicable for NCC, NSS and other co-curricular activity.
8. On the date notified at the back of the front cover page of Prospectus, a merit list of the eligible candidates in all the categories for the course concerned shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the respective department along with the date of personal interview and document verification.
9. All candidates whose names appear in the merit list and subsequently in the merit of admissions after getting information shall have to deposit the fee in the name of the **Registrar, MDS University Ajmer** as per the fee schedule given for each course in the Prospectus. On the failure to deposit the fee and original transfer certificate by the notified date, the claim of the candidate for admission shall be forfeited.
10. Physical presence of a candidate shall be considered only on the submission of original mark sheet of the qualifying examination along with the fee, failing which he/she shall be considered unwilling to seek admission. However on the recommendation of admission committee the candidate may submit the Transfer Certificate after the date of counseling but within the time period given by the admission committee. If the candidate fails in depositing the Transfer Certificate within the time limit so specified, his/her claim will stand forfeited and fee so deposited will not be refunded in any case.
11. If a candidate has applied for admission to more than one course and is admitted to one of them, subsequent to which his/her name appears in the merit list of another course showing entitlement to admission then he/she will have the option to choose either of the course subject to the adjustment of the fee.
12. Subsequent merit lists shall be displayed on the notice board of respective departments if seats remain vacant however candidates once called shall not be called again. When all the candidates who have applied for admission have been called for counseling and even then the seats remain vacant, the admission committee of the concerned department may give chance to those candidates who did not turn up in the counseling earlier. This chance shall be given in order of merit. The concerned department will display the list of such candidates on the Notice Board, who did not turn up in the previous counseling. If the seats still remain vacant the admission committee may seek permission from the Vice Chancellor to invite fresh applications and complete the admissions following the procedures stated above. The admission of candidates already admitted in the department will not be affected even if the university/department decides to invite fresh applications to fill the vacant seats.
13. Please see the instructions given in the Application Form also.

ADMISSIONS IN THE SUBSEQUENT YEARS

(ANNUAL SCHEME AND SEMESTERS)

1. In the Semester based courses, if the result of the previous semester is awaited by the date of commencement of the session then the students shall be promoted to the next semester on the basis of an undertaking on a plain paper as per the format below:

2. For the II year and III/V Semester, the student will have to fill up the form as per the Prospectus and deposit the prescribed fee for the complete one academic session after having passed the previous semester, else the admission shall stand cancelled.
3. The fee deposited as per point 1 or 3 shall not be refunded.
4. An applicant who is declared eligible to appear at the supplementary examination, may be provisionally admitted, at his/her own risk, to the next higher class in the beginning of the session by the last date fixed for admission subject to the conditions mentioned in the clause given below. He/she will be assumed to have secured minimum passing marks in the subject of supplementary examination for the purpose of preparation of merit list for admission.
5. A candidate who fails or does not appear at the supplementary examination shall have no right to continue in the next higher class and his/her provisional admission to the next higher class shall stand cancelled automatically. In such cases the fee shall not be refunded.



RESERVATIONS

Reservation of Seats/ Relaxation of Marks for SC, ST OBC, SBC, Physically Handicapped, Transgender, Displaced Kashmiri Candidates and University Employee, employee's spouse/son or daughter.

- b) Five percent of the total number of seats in each course in the faculties specified in (a) above will be reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates(enclose certificate as per note ii) and one percent for displaced Kashmiri candidates in all the categories.
- c) Super numeral seats in each course run by the university teaching departments shall be reserved for the University Employees (teacher, officer and non teaching staff), employee's spouse/son or daughter. These additional seats will be in addition to the total number of seats allotted in that particular course. The admission under this reserved category will be made on the basis of merit of applicants under this category. One additional seat will be reserved for the University wards having 20 seats per course. In case of 40 seats, 2 seats will be reserved for the University employees/ wards. This reservation would also be applicable for admission to those courses where university entrance examination is conducted. However, the reservation would not be applicable for admission to those courses where state level entrance test examination is conducted. In case of equal marks obtained by two or more candidates after calculating the merit, preference will be given to non-income tax payers.
- d) Two super numeral seats shall be created for students from Jammu and Kashmir in all courses.



- e) All Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes, OBC, SBC, PH, Transgender and displaced Kashmiri candidates who have passed the qualifying examination for admission to the course(s) in the university shall be arranged in the order of merit among themselves. Non creamy OBC Certificate validity is one financial year or as per Government Direction from time to time.
- f) Special relaxation for wards of Kashmiri migrants as per the MHRD Secondary and Higher Education Department GOI letter no. 3-1/2012-NER dated 27.2.2012
1. Extension in the date of admission by about 30 days.
 2. Relaxation in cut off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
 3. Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course wise.
 4. Reservation of atleast 1 seat in merit quota in technical/professional institutions.
 5. Waiving of domicile requirement.
- g) For SC/ST/OBC/SBC candidates:-
- i. Those who have secured marks above the level upto which general category students are admitted, should not be counted towards reserved quota at all and should be included in the general merit list of admissions.
 - ii. Excluding those admitted on merit along with General Candidates as at (i) above, other Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, OBC and SBC candidates should be admitted in the order of merit going down the inter-se-merit list to the extent of availability of seats in the particular category.
 - iii. It is clarified that in order to fill the reservation quota, there should be no hesitation to go down, if necessary, to the pass percentage of the qualifying examination (i.e. B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Pass Course as well as Honours degree for admission to a Post-Graduation).
 - iv. In case of non-availability of SC candidate(s) the reserve seat(s) for SC shall be filled in by ST candidates, if available. Similarly, in case of non-availability of ST candidate(s), the reserve seat(s) of ST shall be filled in by SC candidates, if available.
 - v. Left over SC/ST/OBC/SBC reserved seats could be filled in by general category of the candidates by concerned Head of Department/ Incharge/ Director in case of non-availability of SC/ST/OBC/SBC candidates after taking permission from Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.
- h). Wards of armed personnel : Priority will be decided (as per letter S. No. 6(1)/2017/D(RES.II) Dated Nov. 30 2017 of Ministry of Defence Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare Government of India.
- 3 % seats will be reserved for wards of armed personnel killed in action or of personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service / died while in service with death attributable to military service / disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service or wards of personnel awarded gallantry award or wards of awarded Ex servicemen.

Note:

- i. Candidates belonging to above categories will be required to produce a certificate to that effect from a District Magistrate/Tehsildar/Sub-Divisional Magistrate, ACEM without which their cases will not be considered under the above provisions (O-81-II).
- ii. Candidates claiming concession under clause (b) above shall be required to furnish a certificate in original from the Principal of any Medical College of Rajasthan/Director, Rehabilitation Research Centre/Head of the Department concerned of any Medical College of Rajasthan, CMHO, Health Department of Rajasthan.
- iii. The latest directions issued by the Govt. of Rajasthan related to reservation policy for admissions in higher learning institutions will be applicable.

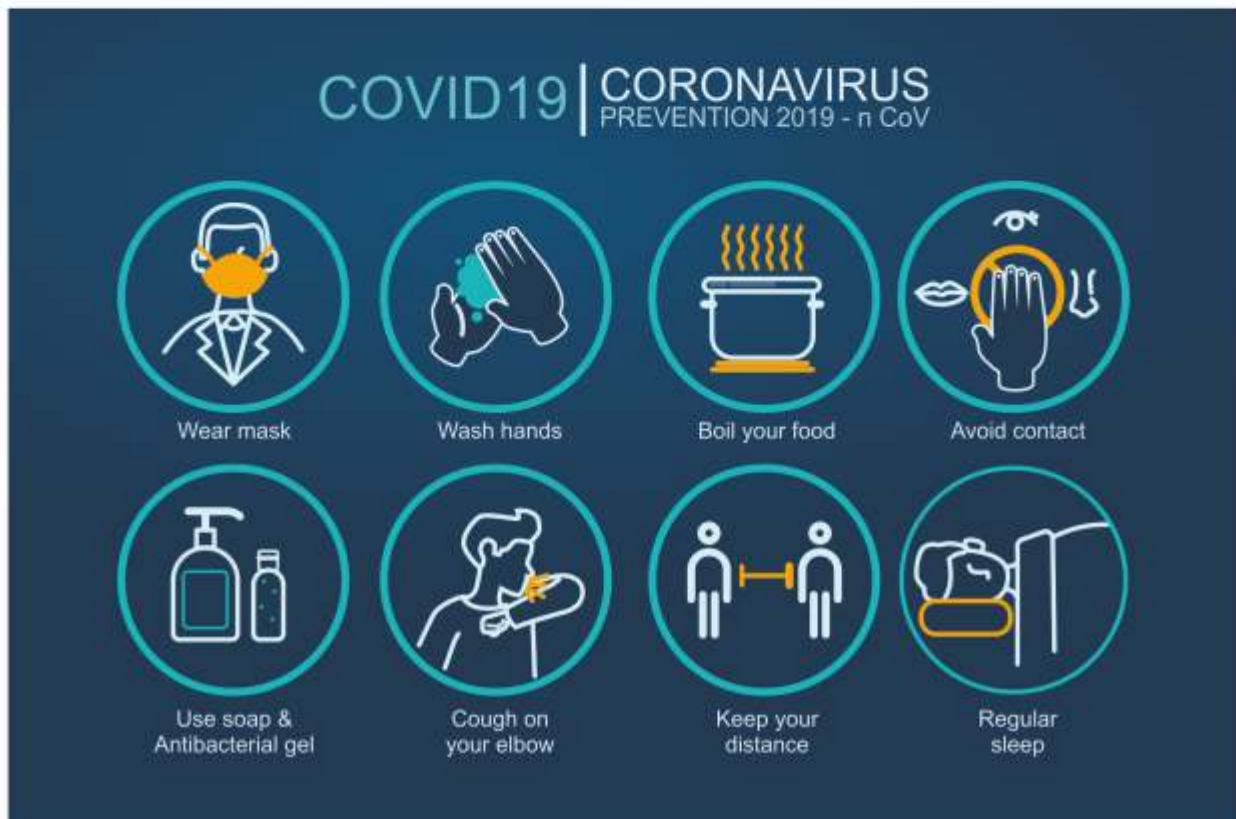

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT & NRI

1. Admission to foreign students shall be given as per the policies of the Government of India (Ministries of External Affairs, Home and Human Resource Development) declared from time to time.
2. The admission of self-supporting students will be confirmed only after having sought clearance from the Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Education), Government of India, New Delhi or High Commission/Embassy concerned.
3. The foreign students are required to submit a medical certificate including report of HIV test from the specified authority at the time of their admission.
4. Minimum eligibility for admission shall be 60% marks in aggregate at the qualifying examination.
5. Incomplete application form will not be entertained.
6. Application must accompany a receipt of worth Rs. 1000/- as processing fee in favour of the Registrar, Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University, Ajmer
7. A caution money of Rs. 5000/- shall be charged from the self-supporting foreign students if they have been provided with hostel accommodation.
8. No direct application / documents of the foreign students who wish to seek admission to P G course/ Ph. D. course will be entertained by the Head of the Teaching Departments/ Supervisors for Ph.D. course. They are required to submit the same to the office of the Dean, Student Welfare of the university to ascertain the eligibility.
9. The foreign students are required to maintain good conduct during the course of studies in the University. The Chief Proctor can take disciplinary action in case of defaulters. Fees and other dues must be cleared on time.
10. Every International student shall report to Foreign Registration Officer, for extension of his/her visa three months in advance. They shall keep close liaison with foreign Registration Office regarding visa formalities, etc.
11. All admissions shall be provisional till all formalities are completed.
12. All other Rules for local students will also apply to the International students.
13. All inquiries and duly filled in application form for admission should be addressed to the Dean, Student Welfare, Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University, Ajmer.
14. 15% supernumerary seats in all courses will be reserved for International Students including Persons of Indian Origin. Out of 15% supernumerary seats 1/3 i.e. 5% seats would be preferably filled by children of NRIs on payment of five times the fee payable by a regular student of the course.
15. Familiarization session would be organized for freshly enrolled international students for at least three weeks prior to the commencement of the academic session. This session would provided interaction with authorities and would also include inputs on specific and relevant information about the region, city and suburbs, local customs, culture, language, civil facilities etc.

One Scholarship each of rupees 250/- per month for 12 months shall be given to the meritorious students of each batch of M.Phil/Advance Diploma/ PG Diploma/Diploma Courses and one each studying in the previous and final years of M.A./M.Sc./M.Com./MBA or equivalent master degree course. Also to the topper studying in the UG course Part I, Part II and Part III and to the student in the I semester and III semester for those studying in semester scheme.

At the entry level in each course the topper of the entrance examination or if admissions are made on the basis of % of marks at the graduate degree level, then the topper on the basis aggregate of marks in the qualifying examination shall be eligible for scholarship in courses having more than one year duration the toppers of the previous year shall be eligible for the scholarship.

To ensure that the scholarship is earned by a genuine candidate the student who does not fill up/ is not eligible to fill up the examination form shall not be considered eligible for the scholarship.

STUDENT ASSISTANTSHIP

University has a provision of student assistantship where in students in each department, if willing, may be asked to perform various duties to assist in administrative works for which they will be paid in an earn-while-you-learn pattern. The programmes are subject to necessary office order issued by the University from time to time.

NEED CUM MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

The objective of the Scheme is to provide financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students to enable them to pursue higher education. These scholarships are available for students studying at the Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University Campus only and will be awarded through the Office of the Dean, Student Welfare.

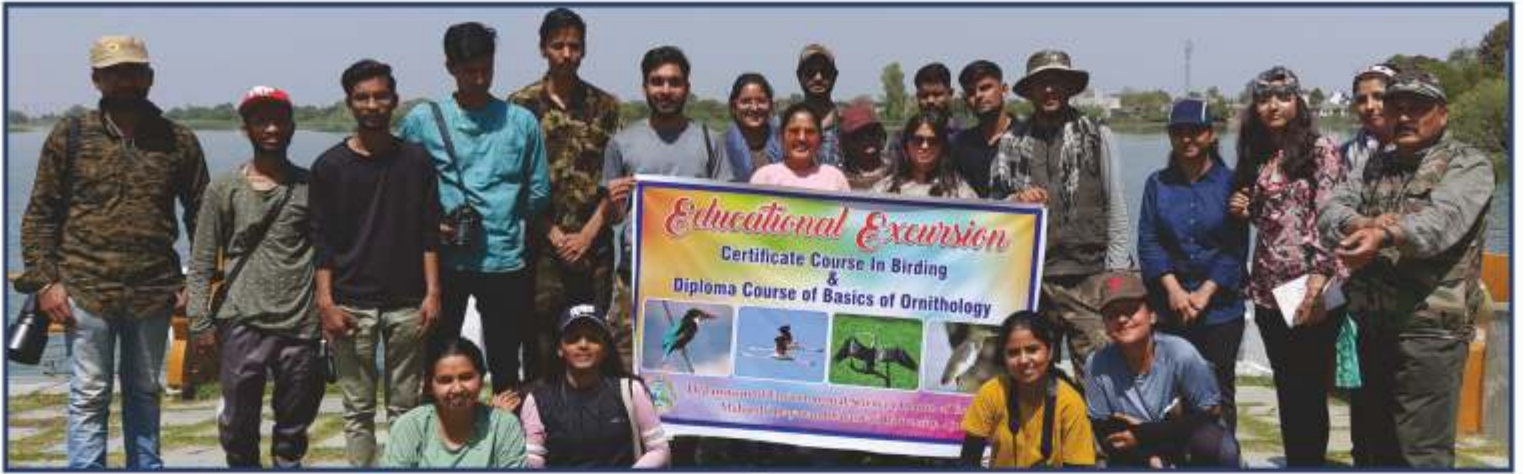
- These scholarships are available for studies in all UG and PG courses in the M.D.S. University Campus, Ajmer.

CENTERS / CELLS

CENTER FOR ENTREPRENEURSHIP & SMALL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT (ESBM)

This Center is successfully running in the University Campus. It was established in April, 2004 and is India's first University based Entrepreneurship Development Institute. The Center offers MBA with Dual specialization, MBA Executive Programme and BBA in Entrepreneurship and Family Business Management.

HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT CENTER (HRDC)

The UGC-Human Resource Development Center (HRDC) of the University has been established to conduct UGC Sponsored Teacher Training Programmes as Orientation, Refresher courses, Summer and Winter schools and short term courses for College and University Teachers.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) instills a momentum of quality and consciousness in Higher Educational Institutions leading to continuous institutional improvement. NAAC advocates the establishment of an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) by every accredited institution as a post accreditation measure. Hence to make quality enhancement an integral part of institutional functioning, the MDS University has also established an IQAC to generate good practices and ideas for planning, implementing and measuring the outcome of its academic and administrative performance.

ALGAE BIOFUEL & BIOMOLECULES CENTRE

An interdisciplinary research centre comprising faculty from Departments of Microbiology, Environmental Science, Food Science & Nutrition, Economics and Centre for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management with an aim to design and develop a system for the purpose of simultaneous production of biofuel(s) and other biomolecules through mass cultivation of algae at a low cost. It also aims imparting training in these areas.

DR. B. R. AMBEDKAR SHODH PEETH

Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Shodh Peeth was established during Convocation Ceremony on October 6, 2015 when Hon'ble Governor of Rajasthan Shri Kalyan Singh had put forth the need for Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Shodh Peeth and the Vice Chancellor Prof Kailash Sodani has immediately announced for the Peeth with funding of Rs. one crore from the Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University Ajmer. It is spacious and capable of providing varieties of services to Teachers, Scholars, Student and Public by regularly organizing Lecture series, Seminars, Conference, Discussion, Exchange of thoughts, Symposia and conducting field based studies for grass root planning.

The **vision** is to ensure social emancipation, economic empowerment, educational excellence and participation of Dalit in Nation Building. The main **motto** of studying the socio-economic status of the SC/ST population in Rajasthan to enlist every major and minor problem needs of the communities and to the other related research studies. It is also intended to perform evaluation study on the ongoing schemes, programmes of the Peeth to see the extent to which they have been successful and reach the deserved class and people, since such studies throw more light deeper than the administrative inspection reports.

PRITHVI RAJ CHAUHAN ETIHASIK EVAM SANSKRITIK SHODH KENDRA

Ajmer has its historical significance since the prehistoric age. During 6th or 7th century B.C. the Chauhan Rajputs occupied the region and founded the Chauhan empire. The great ruler Prithviraj Chauhan the ruler of Ajmer and Delhi also has great significance. Ajaypal was the founder of Ajmer or Ajmer. Due to not only religious or cultural importance of the province but due to the strategic importance of the region Ajmer was remain centre of political and diplomatic activities of various rulers. The Turks, the Mugals, the Marathas and the British occupied Ajmer. Similarly Ajmer changed hands among the rulers of Rajputana and the Marwar and Mewar. In 1956 the Ajmer Merwara state was integrated with the state of Rajasthan.

MDS University, Ajmer established the Shodh Kendra in 1997. The objectives mainly are to study and research the history and culture of Rajasthan particularly. To achieve the objective the Shodh Kendra is expected to work on the following targets-

1. Survey of Rajasthan for its socio-cultural heritage
2. Collect original sources for archiving and preserving them as photocopies at the centre
3. Conduct research to establish facts in the history of Rajasthan.
4. Organize seminars, conferences, workshops and training on historical and cultural history of heritage rich Rajasthan and publish research journal
5. Publish material related to the history of Rajasthan.

SINDHU SHODH PEETH

The Sindhu Shodh Peeth (S S P) was established on 21-9-2015 in the Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University campus as a Research Centre. The inception of the S S P was started in the month of February 2015, when the University organized two day National conference on "Sindhi Story-Centenary Celebration, 13-14 Feb. 2015". Thereafter, the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India decided to sanction Rs. One crore to promote Sindhi language through National Council for Promotion of Sindhi Language.

Thrust Area : The Thrust area of Sindhu Shodh Peeth will be research, teaching, translation and extension activities etc. through Sindhi, English and Hindi languages

Objectives : The objective of Sindhu Shodh Peeth is to provide research facilities for students, academicians, intellectuals to undertake studies and research work on the subjects related to Sindhu Civilization (Mohan-jo-darro & Harrapa), Sindhi language & Literature, Sindhi Art & Culture, Social strata of Sindhi Population and History of Sindhi population.

MAHARSHI DAYANAND SHODH PEETH

The Maharshi Dayanand Shodhpeeth was established in 2016 on the behest of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and Governor of Rajasthan Shri Kalyan Singh Ji. The Board of Management (BoM) of the University in its 90th meeting dated August 29, 2016, vide item No. 24 gave consent to create this Shodhpeeth. Shodhpeeth would do research work and study the life, works and study Maharshi Dayanand's interpretation of Vedas and his other works.

The University is trying to get The Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati Chair within the Shodhpeeth, from the UGC so that the following functions and objectives related to academic, research and extension nature are achieved:

1. To carry out research on the life and works of Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati vis-à-vis on Veda and contribution to the advancement of knowledge.
2. To strengthen the role of University and academics in making public policy particularly with reference to social reforms.
3. To design and execute short term/ long term capacity development programmes for teachers and researchers in higher education related to Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati's work.
4. To publish articles/ research papers/ reports/ monographs/ books/ book chapters on Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati in National and International Journals/ Periodicals/ books etc.
5. To participate in Teaching and Ph D programmes of the Department of Vedic Vangmaya and in other relevant programmes of the University.
6. To undertake extension activities in the form of organising popular lectures on Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati/ Veda/ Rituals/ Hawan performance etc. at appropriate platforms.
7. To develop a network of related organizations devoted to Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati and Arya Samaj Like Paropkarni Sabha, Ajmer.

RESOURCES AND FACILITIES

The Central Library housed in a separate three storied library building named 'Saraswat Bhawan' in an area of 5100 sq. mtr. approx. with immense textual and non-textual reading material in variety of documents concerned with different subjects. In addition to the general & reference books (53100), the collection also covers sufficient periodicals (221 current+4720 back volumes), reports (1240), conference proceedings, statistics, audio-visual material CDs/ CD Databases. The Central Library is fully computerized since June 2003, with technical and financial assistance of the UGC's INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar; using SOUL 2.0.0.14 software developed by the INFLIBNET Centre with other operating systems and application software; comprising of complete Database of Books, Theses and Periodicals. The Central Equipment Facility has hi-tech equipments for research as Fourier Transformation Infra Red Spectroscopy (FTIR), a Gel Documentation System, Polymerase Chain Reactor (PCR) and Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer (AAS). In addition, various departments of science are equipped with High Tech Laboratories with facilities such as Bioacoustic analysis, Microphotographic analysis, Oxitop BOD System, HPLC, CO₂ incubator, Ultrasonicator, Brookfield Viscometer, Gas Chromatographs and Auto Nitrogen analyzer.

Every student enrolled in the University should maintain strict discipline and decorum governed under the Ordinances and Statutes of this University. Any act of misconduct committed by a student inside or outside the campus shall be an act of violation of discipline of the University.

Violations of the discipline shall include:

1. Disruption of teaching, student examination, research or administrative work, curricular or extra-curricular activity or residential life of the members of the University, including any attempt to prevent any member of the University or its staff from carrying out his or her work; and any act reasonably likely to cause such disruption.
2. Damaging or defacing University property or the property of members of the University or any other property inside or outside the University campus.
3. Engaging in any attempt at wrongful confinement of teachers, officers, employees and students of the University or camping inside or creating nuisance inside the boundaries of houses of teachers, officers and other members of the University.
4. Use of abusive and derogatory slogans or intimidatory language or incitement of hatred and violence or any act calculated to further the same.
5. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the University Campus/ Constituent Colleges and outside University Campus. Students are advised to go through the 'Anti Ragging' section of the prospectus.
6. Every student residing in the Hostels of this University should strictly obey the above rules as well as rules and regulations of the Hostels.
7. Student should maintain discipline in the Campus, on educational tours, On-the-job training, summer training etc.
8. Students are prohibited to indulge in any kind of activity like teasing, ragging, molesting, physical harassment, mental harassment, smoking and drinking alcoholic beverages, etc.
9. Rules of attendance will be applicable as per the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan.
10. Inside University campus a student must always carry identity card with him/her and shall produce whenever asked for by the authorities, teachers and/or University Security Staff.

Students found involved in any kind of indisciplinary activities will be subjected to punishment from the University Authorities.

RAGGING

UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and as per the provisions of anti-ragging verdict by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide SLP No (s) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs Council, Principals', Colleges, Kerala and Ors (with SLP(C) No.24296-99/2004 and W.P. (CrI) No. 173/2006 and SLP(C) No.14356/2005)

Ragging means the following

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness another student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Punishable ingredients of ragging:

- Abetment to ragging
- Criminal conspiracy to ragging
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- Public nuisance created during ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful restraint
- Use of criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences
- Extortion
- Criminal trespass
- Offences against property
- Criminal intimidation
- Physical or psychological humiliation
- All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging"
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)



MEASURES FOR ENCOURAGING HEALTHY INTERACTION BETWEEN FRESHERS AND SENIORS

The institution shall set up appropriate committees including the course in charge, student advisor, Warden and some senior students to actively monitor, promote and regulate healthy interaction between the freshers and senior students.

Freshers' welcome parties shall be organized in each department by the senior students and the faculty together soon after admissions, preferably within the first two weeks of the beginning of the academic session, for proper introduction to one another and where the talents of the freshers are brought out properly in the presence of the faculty, thus helping them to shed their inferiority complex, if any, and remove their inhibitions.

Punishments

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the University, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the University level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Cancellation of admission
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- Fine ranging between Rupees 25,000/- and Rupees 1 lakh
- Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the University shall resort to collective punishment.

Note :

Student and his/her parent/Guardian is also required to go through the relevant UGC regulation on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions. Student are required to sign an affidavit and submit the same with the application form.
